Peschiera del Garda is a city rich in history and art. Due to its strategic location, leading powers have always battled for control of the town, and over time these have modified and enhanced the structure of the town. Today, Peschiera is a rare example of an island fortified by the Republic of Veneto, still perfectly preserved today. Walking through its streets, you will come across a number of monuments dating back to the main periods in history which have marked it: from the Roman remains to the outline of the medieval Scaliger castle; from the Rocca del Cavaliere to the Fortezza Veneta and the Austrian military headquarters. To make it easier for you to discover this heritage, a historic and artistic guided tour has been developed with the assistance and willingness of the citizens of Peschiera. This will allow you to discover what our town has to offer, in a straightforward and easy to understand way. This tour is described on the following pages, illustrated with a short text and extensive photographs. To help you on your way, a plan of Peschiera has been drawn up, showing the locations of the buildings referred to. In the following pages you will find information regarding the Museum found inside Palazzina Storica dedicated to the historic Allied Conference held at Peschiera del Garda November 8th 1917. In recent years our City's administration has invested in the museum's renovation and development and created a cataloguing of all the cultural heritage preserved inside as well as extending active participation in this historic building's preservation.
